



Open Call

For the traveling exhibition Kein schöner ____ in dieser Zeit through Thuringia we are looking for artistic positions for the public space

How do we want to live together well in a migration society in the future? We want to start a conversation about this important question by means of art in public space in well-attended places in Thuringia. We see a lack of direct encounters between people of different origins and socialization as one reason why right-wing and anti-democratic narratives catch on. This is where we want to start with our exhibition, create a platform for such an exchange and bring together people with different experiences and backgrounds who grew up and/or live in Thuringia.

Through art, we want to make **perspectives from East Germany** visible and tangible, which have so far received too little attention. We are looking for artistic works that deal with East German reality from the **perspective of migrants who lived in the GDR**, such as contract workers. Furthermore, we **focus on narratives of post-migrants from Thuringia and refugees to East Germany.** We also invite artists to submit works that deal with the **reappraisal of GDR history and East German experiences of change through the Wende and post-reunification period**, such as artistic positions that deal with the SED dictatorship or the Treuhand.

We hope to create mutual understanding through appreciation and visualization of biographies/experiences and shared experiences with art.

The exhibition will tour through Suhl, Nordhausen and Saalfeld from the end of August to mid-September 2022 and will be a guest in each of these cities for one week in a public place. The works will be presented on an exhibition system that we are developing together with our cooperation partner, the award-winning Kollektiv Plus X, and which will also be a social meeting place. The exhibition will be accompanied by a supporting and mediation program educational service program with manyparticipatory offerings: from a storytelling café to workshops with artists to panel discussions.







We are looking for

1) artistic works (all media) that will become part of our permanent exhibition system. Please submit proposals for a weatherproof presentation. It is also desired to include a participatory offer, such as workshops or works that directly involve visitors, for example, through instructions for action. You get extra money for running an educational service offer.

2) performative works / performances / theater etc., which will be shown at one or more exhibition venues. Individual arrangements are possible.

We offer

- exhibition fee (exhibition fee 300 € for visual arts / 500 €
- performance / theater)
- travel expenses and accommodation if necessary
- production costs of 250 € for visual arts
- public relations (print, press and social media)

In addition, you will get to know committed people/initiatives in the cities who are working for a democratic and solidary Thuringia.

Conditions

Willingness to travel to at least one of the exhibition venues in Thuringia and to collaborate with other artists or to be present at the exhibition on selected dates.
